FULL-DAY ITINERARY

07:00**Pickup at Chiquilá**

Meet at the ferry pier on the mainland. Coffee and quick briefing.

07:30**Ferry to Holbox**

30-minute crossing to Isla Holbox. Sunrise over the mangroves if you're lucky.

08:15**Boat departure**

Small panga north to the feeding grounds. Marine biologist explains what to look for.

09:00**First swim with whale sharks**

Two swimmers at a time enter the water alongside a feeding whale shark. Repeat as long

as safe.

10:30

Second swim

A different animal if we're lucky. Manta rays and dolphins are common bycatch.

12:00

Ceviche lunch on Passion Island

Landing on a sandbar off Holbox for ceviche and a beer. Bird-watching for flamingos in season.

15:00

Return to Holbox

Back to the village pier. Ferry back to Chiquilá whenever you like.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Boat, gear, biologist, and the licence to be there

— SMALL BOAT

Six guests max on a licensed p ãev à No crowd, no waiting your turn to swim.

— MARINE BIOLOGIST

A biologist guides each swim: how to approach, how far to stay, and what you're seeing.

— CEVICHE LUNCH

Fresh ceviche and beers on Passion Island after the swim. Vegetarian option with notice.

— SNORKEL GEAR

Mask, snorkel, fins, and life vest — mandatory around whale sharks and yours for the day.

— PARK PERMITS

Whale Shark Biosphere Reserve and national sanctuary fees, paid on your behalf.

— WEATHER PROMISE

If seas are unsafe or sharks don't show, we reschedule or refund. No pressure to go out.
